WINEMAKING:

Whole clusters of Pinot Noir from the Calesa Vineyard are hand-picked and carefully sorted. Direct press with minimal skin contact ensures approachable tannins and soft pink color. Slow stainless fermentation at low temperature preserves bright acidity and airy aroma. Body and structure are built in barrel, aged for six months sur lie in neutral French oak.

TASTING NOTES:

A breezy and bright rosé reflective of its origins on those sunny windswept slopes of the Calesa Vineyard in Petaluma Gap. Wafts of cherry skin, strawberry purée, and red hard candy pique the nose, while layers of lavender oil and sea salt slip over the tongue. Some wines have grip, this one has charge... it's almost electric.
